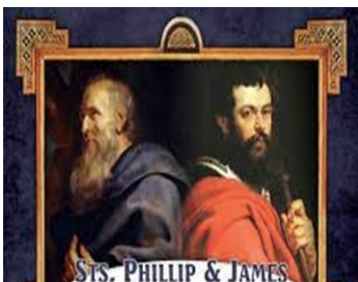

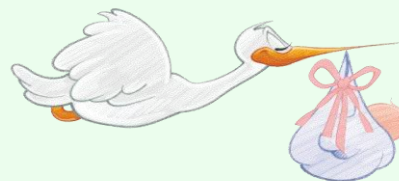


#### **Year 5 Residential to Sayers Croft**

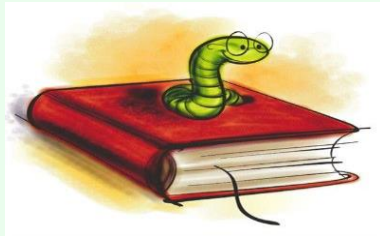
